



FACILITY RENTAL INFORMATION

Whether you are looking for a place to hold your next birthday celebration (your 9th or your 90th!) or you are looking for a formal setting for a business meeting, we can work with you to provide space. We provide complete set-up, tear down, several amenities and different room set-ups to meet your needs.

***Poolside (seating for 45)**

Picnic tables, refrigerator, sink and chairs

\$125 members/\$175 community for 2 hour rental (\$200/\$250 for 3 hours)

***Generation A (lecture (75), classroom (40), round tables + chairs (60))**

Full kitchen, projector and screen, sound

\$125 members/\$175 community for 2 hour rental (\$200/\$250 for 3 hours)

***Generation B (lecture (75), classroom (40), round tables + chairs (60))**

Sink, refrigerator, projector and screen, sound

\$125 members/\$175 community for 2 hour rental (\$200/\$250 for 3 hours)

***Gen A+B (lecture (150), round tables + chairs (110))**

Kitchen, two projectors, two screens, sound

\$200 members, \$250 community participants for 2 hour rental (\$250/\$300 for 3 hours)

***Rental times for birthday parties wanting to swim**

Fridays 5:30-7:30pm

Saturdays 12:45-2:45pm (3:45pm extra hour), 3:30-5:30pm

Sundays 1-3pm (4pm extra hour)

***All other rentals (group meetings, baby showers, corporate, etc.)**

can be scheduled any time that the space is available per the calendar.

***One hour room only rentals are \$75.**

Rules of Operation

- Full payment is due at time of booking.
- You will be allowed an additional 30 minutes of set-up prior to your rental time.
- **All party guests must sign in at the Welcome Center upon arrival.**
- Rental of the Poolside Room, Generation Rooms A and/or B/Adventure Center, does not provide guests access to the YMCA exercise equipment or gym area. Party guests are permitted to use the YMCA lobby area, rest rooms, family changing rooms and locker rooms located in the main hall of the facility.
- Decorations are not to be attached to the walls or ceilings with thumbtacks or push-pins.
- All food and beverage items must remain in your room throughout your event due to food allergies. **All alcoholic beverages and smoking** are prohibited on YMCA property.
- Please place all trash in the receptacles located in the party/meeting room.
- Please make sure all of your personal belongings are removed from the room when you leave **by the end of the second hour if you are having a 3 hour party.** The YMCA is not responsible for anything left in the party area while guests are swimming.
- Party attendant(s) will come into the party room approximately 30 minutes prior to the end of the rental and assist as needed in cleaning up.

AUTHORIZATION DAMAGE CHARGE: Any damage to the facility during the rental will be the responsibility of the individual hosting the rental. If there is any damage to the facility or any equipment, a \$50 damage fee will be charged immediately. This must be paid prior to leaving on the day of the function.

Pool Rules for Parties

- The party attendant or lifeguard must go over the pool rules **BEFORE** the guests are allowed in the pool.
- **Adults need to be prepared to stay in the pool area for the duration of the swim time.**
- **Children and adults must wear their party band and swim band at all times.**
- **Each child ages 14 and under not wanting to wear a lifejacket will be required to take a swim test** which consists of swimming one length of the pool without touching the side or stopping. Any child not passing the test, will be issued a **RED** swim band or **BLUE** swim band (ages 5 & under as well as parent). If and when they pass the test, they will receive a **GREEN** swim band.
- Child **MUST** have a **GREEN BAND** to use the lap pool, diving board, and slide.
- **The YMCA requires (!) adult (must be 18 years or older) for every (5) children between the ages of 6-8 years old to be dressed in swimwear and in the pool with them for added supervision**
- **If there are not enough adults to swim with each age group, THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Any child who does not pass the swim test and is not 1:1 with an adult is required to wear a **USCG** approved lifejacket. **If a child (ages 5 7 under) does not have a life jacket, an adult (must be 18 or older) must be with that child (1:1) within arm's reach.**
- The lifeguard's responsibility is to ensure the safety of all swimmers. **Parents** need to be prepared to help the child with life jacket, swimwear, and personal needs. Please have the children use the restroom prior to entering the pool and check with them often to avoid accidents in the pool. **Any child who is not potty trained must wear a swim diaper.**

To induce the YMCA of Greater Kansas City to grant the license applied for, the organization, and the person signing below on its behalf (its "representative") warrant that (1) the information is, to the best of their knowledge, true, and (2) they understand and agree to abide and be bound by the terms of the Facility Rental Agreement and Rules of Operation printed on this contract, (3) the person signing as representative has full authority to do so on the organization's behalf, and (4) the fee for the rental will be paid in stated.
